Melia shared, " I learned that I need to obey God. I knew He is loving and all- powerful. I cannot do anything I want if God is not with me. He is the One who gives me strength. I hold on to His promise in Philippians 4:13 – I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. *Pls. pray that I could be able to graduate this school year; avoid any temptations and not be disqualified at Tekno.
