MISSION NEWSBITS

Carabao Updates:

Ganda and Yumi are not yet ready to reproduce up to this time according to our beneficiaries, Mable and Jimmy.

Mable tried to bring Ganda to a male carabao but she refused it. The two carabaos are growing big and are healthy. They are useful now in the farm. Mable and Jimmy are both happy to have the carabaos. Other Mangyans desire to have carabaos too. One of them felt envious because he was not chosen to be the first beneficiary of this project. He didn't attend anymore in the church.



Health Updates:

Some of the sick Mangyans were already healed, but still many of them are sick. Several Tekno kids were absent from one to two weeks because they got sick. Thank God for His answers to our prayers: we conducted free medical-dental mission on December 26; and some friends donate fund for medicines. Praise God for medicines and volunteer doctors and dentists for our medical-dental mission.

“Matira, Matibay” na Tekno kids: (The deserving Tekno kids.)

We now have 27 Tekno kids who are not disqualified in the Tekno Center. These are the deserving Tekno kids who truly wants to be developed in their spiritual and physical lives. Many boys and few girls were already disqualified because of absences, cutting classes, and disobedience to rules. Among the big boys, only Arthur, 2nd year high school, stays till now. Arthur started with Tekno when he was in Grade 1.

Meraly Updates:

At last, we heard good comments from Meraly's teacher this time. She said Meraly improves a lot in reading and in obedience. She didn't go out and play anymore during their classes. She didn't hurt anyone too. She wants to stay at their home but we cannot allow her because she easily got sick due to of lack of food and lack of discipline from her loved ones. This holiday break, she will stay longer with her loved ones. Pls. pray that she'll not get sick during this time.

Christmas Celebration:

We conducted three Christmas fellowship on December 17 , Mangyan Church; December 18, Parents Christmas fellowship and December 19, Tekno kids Christmas fellowship. Praise God for the food and gifts sent by our Partners for our celebration.
